House Rules for Laundry

- 1. Do laundry only on your day, unless you ask permission.

 Put your magnetic name on the machine(s) you are using.
- 2. Be sure to provide empty basket(s) next to the dryer, one for each load in progress.
- 3. If there is dry laundry in the dryer when you begin, place it in their laundry basket and move it to the folding counter. If it is still damp, run it again first.
- 4. If there is laundry in the washer when you begin, put it in the dryer (if you are able) and collect \$10 from the offender! Unless a note is left, set the dryer to these settings:

a. Dryer Temperature PERM PRESS MEDIUM HEAT

b. Cycle Signal OFF

c. Time: AUTOMATIC REGULAR, More

Do not remove someone's wet laundry from the washer without putting it into the dryer: Mildew hazard.

- 5. If there is laundry left on the folding counter from 2 or more days previous, move it to their room (if you are able) and collect \$10 from the offender!
- 6. Offenders must pay up by Sunday at 12 noon or be subject to additional \$10 late fee penalty to the enforcer.

If you choose not to abide by these rules you may forfeit your laundry day and use public laundry facilities.
